

List of anti-COVID measures:

1. Full vaccination required for all participants (staff included):

Only persons who have completed a full course of vaccination are allowed to the YES meeting (here and after referred to as the Event), which is confirmed by an international, internal or foreign certificate of vaccination/prevention from COVID-19 approved by the World Health Organization (Moderna, Pfizer / BioNTech, Johnson & Johnson, AstraZeneca, Covishield, Sinopharm and Sinovac). A scanned copy of the certificate is handed to the Event organizers when filling out the online registration form.

2. COVID testing for all participants and staff

As an additional safety precaution, there is going to be a mandatory rapid COVID-19 testing for all participants and staff on 09.09.2021 available in two locations:

- For foreign participants — in a specially designated room at the Hyatt Regency Hotel (Ally Tarasovoi St, 5, Kyiv) immediately after check-in at the hotel. The mobile laboratory is provided on 09.09.2021 from 8.00-20.00.
- Staff and participants — in a specially designated zone at Mystetskyi Arsenal (Lavrska St, 10-12, Kyiv). The mobile laboratory at Mystetskyi Arsenal is set to be provided 09 - 11.09.2021 according to the schedule: September 9 — from 8.00 to 23.00, September —10 from 7.00 to 23.00, September 11 —from 7.00 to 21.00

All staff must be tested prior to the start of the Event during the day of 09.09 until 16.30

10-11.09.201 participants will have an opportunity to voluntarily pass an express antigen test, and foreign participants, if necessary, — a PCR test (if the negative COVID test is mandatory to cross the border on the way back). The PCR test result will be provided within 12 hours from the moment the laboratory receives the material for research, therefore participants should contact the laboratory in advance.

PCR test for foreign guests after the end of the Event requires a separate request.

A negative antigen test result is confirmed by a sticker attached to the badge.

In case of a positive antigen test result, participants are given the option to pass an additional control PCR test. Participants who have tested positive with the antigen and PCR test are NOT allowed to participate in the event.

Staff who have tested positive for COVID-19 are NOT allowed to participate in the event.

3. Temperature control

Temperature check is carried out at the entrance to the Mystetskyi Arsenal using contactless thermometers and/or automatic temperature control system. Persons with a temperature above 37.2°C (98.96°F) after additional temperature check, examination by a doctor and a doctor's conclusion about signs of a respiratory disease are NOT allowed to participate in the Event.

4. Social distancing

Following the social distance no less than 1 m (3.3 f) is mandatory for all participants of the Event.

5. Masks

Masks, throughout the whole Event, are mandatory for staff and preferable for participants. The organizers will provide a sufficient number of disposable three-layer masks, made of odorless, hypoallergenic non-woven fabric with elastic bands or ties with fixation on the nose for all participants and staff.

6. Hand sanitizer

Hand hygiene sensor stations with alcohol-based sanitizers are located in sufficient amounts at the entrance to all work areas and dining areas.

7. Staff and participants of the Event are admitted to the territory of the Mystetskyi Arsenal through separate entrances.

8. Ventilation and cleaning

The organizers provide high-quality ventilation of all work areas and dining areas, at the beginning and at the end of the day – wet cleaning of premises with treatment of all contact surfaces with alcohol-based disinfectants. During the Q&A sessions, the microphone is not handed over to the participants.

9. The organizers ensure that the participants are systematically informed (announcements by speakerphone during breaks, information signs in designated places) about the need to adhere to all sanitary anti-epidemiological requirements.
